

Exporting student responses from Class Analysis (Tutorial A8)

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You can export student responses from an assignment using Class Analysis. To do this, first collect an assignment

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that contains Question pages from the class. Next, right-click on the appropriate assignment in the Class Record,

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and choose Open in Class Analysis. Now save it to the class portfolio by clicking the Save to Portfolio icon in the

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toolbar. I'll give this a unique name, and then click Save. Here in the Class Analysis Window, I'll go to File-Export

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Scores. This will open the Export Scores dialog box, where I can give my file a unique name, and then click the Save

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button to save a CSV file. This type of file can be opened in nearly all spreadsheet applications and likely many

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grade book programs. You can also just copy and paste from the Class Analysis window by clicking to highlight the

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appropriate student entries and the headers: be sure the headers are selected, they will not automatically be highlighted.

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I'll press Control-C to copy them to the clipboard. Next, switch to your preferred spreadsheet application, click

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to highlight a cell, and then press Control-V to paste that data into your document.

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
